Grizzly Bear Viewing Tours in Toba Inlet, British Columbia, are hosted by the Klahoose First Nation and partners. Klahoose Coastal Adventures is proudly First Nations owned and operated and a member of the Commercial Bear Viewing Association of BC. Our tour guides are from the local First Nations and are skilled at providing a safe and comfortable experience. Since 2016, we have worked with several highly regarded tour operators partner who will transport guests on day tours from Campbell River to Toba Inlet where we host and guide grizzly bear viewing tours. Guest also arrives as part of our multi-day grizzly bear viewing packages from our own Klahoose Wilderness Resort guests.

Responsibilities will include:

- Welcome guests to the Klahoose territory
- Educate guests on wildlife, natural history, general ecology, grizzly bears and their habitat
- Record keeping
- Cleaning and maintenance duties
